- Up-date about our Joslin Elem website – our PTA Board & CAC minutes are now on the website.
- SAUS – the current chair person is stepping down, there is a new chair person taking over, the current focus is to place a family member in the seat of the School Board member who passed away as an interim

Approval of August minutes: Chris – moves to approve, Phoebe - seconds

Response to requests for information: Staff will be looking at the choices for the new technology rollout at our next meeting, there was a question about innovation stations being added where there are none, it is supposed to be part of the bond, but is not part of the first phase of the bond roll out.

Enrollment & staffing concerns: the district levels schools every year to help with over filled classes in some schools and to move teachers from schools that are under enrolled. Ms Pace shared Joslin's current numbers of students by grade level. PK is currently low, but we have split the classes and are being supported at the district level. Kinder is a huge concern for us right now, we need about 15 students per class, which is 45 students we currently only have 40, we would not lose our bilingually certified teacher. We will hear about it next week. First grade has a good number of students. We have had some turmoil in first grade due to departmentalization and a large number of English Language Learners. As a result we are going back to a self-contained bilingual classroom which will help us address parent concerns and the time needed to provide instruction in English and in Spanihs for our first grade English Language Learners. The other two first grade classes will continue to departmentalize.

Campus Improvement Plan (CIP): The committee looked at tentative campus goals based end of year data from last school year and talked about how to include these goals on the new CIP document. Committee members were encouraged to share ideas/suggestions of campus improvement goals. Ms. Pace will type the strategies into the new CIP form and work on setting measureable goals and will have them ready for the next meeting and solicit committee input for revisions.
